Award of Bronze Star Medal May 30, 1945

William R. Kirby, , First Lieutenant (then Second Lieutenant), Headquarters Company, 735<sup>th</sup> Tank Battalion, for heroic achievement in action against an armed enemy of the United States near Netz, France, on 6 October, 1944. When the tactical situation made it necessary for Lieutenant Kirby to withdraw his tanks to assume defensive positions, he made a personal reconnaissance of a deep tank trap. Realizing the necessity of crossing the trap, Lieutenant Kirby led his tanks to a place where the trap had been partially filled with bomb debris. In spite of heavy small arms fire and artillery fragments, he personally directed the crossing of the barrier, leading his platoon to safety. The exemplary leadership displayed by Lieutenant Kirby reflects the highest credit upon his training as an officer in the United States Army. Entered military service from Missouri.
